Sylvia Woller Memorial Scholarship Guidelines

The Fund available for awards will be based upon the report of earnings to the Chairperson from NTC on 20 quarter average.

The Award Committee will make all the rules governing the distribution of the Award. Presently, these rules are.

- 1. Graduating seniors from Athens High School or Merrill High School must have attended Maple Grove Charter School Grades 1-5.
- 2. Graduating seniors will make an application on form supplied by Athens High School or Merrill High School.
- 3. The Award may be applied toward enrollment in any NTC Class. Sylvia Woller Memorial Scholarship only awarded to students attending NTC Wausau
- 4. An Account will be setup in recipient's name and will draw off of the account in the amount of the awarded held for 3 semester.
- 5. According to the Trust agreement, the basic fund must remain a Trust, regardless of how it is administered and where it is placed.
- 6. Money granted to the recipients must be used within 3 semester awarded or returned to Sylvia Woller Memorial Scholarship Fund.
- 7. A. Attended all grades available at Maple Grove Charter School, beginning with grade one (1), and a graduate of Maple Grove Charter School.
 - B. Attended all remaining grades in the Merrill Area Common Public School District or Athens School District, through grades twelve (12) and a graduate of Merrill High School or Athens High School.
 - C. Was a resident of the Merrill Area Common Public School District or Athens School District.
- 8. Graduating seniors who receive the Walter & Mable Fromm Scholarship are not eligible to receive the Sylvia Woller Memorial Scholarship.
- 9. Any student attending Maple Grove Charter School in the 2021 -2022 school year in grades 1-4 and attends Maple Grove Charter School through the 5th grade and graduated from Athens High School or Merrill High School (12th grade) will be eligible for the Sylvia Woller Memorial Scholarship year ending 2033. This will be complete in 2033.
