

**Board Of Education**

**General Organization – Qualifications, Terms of Office**

The Board of Education shall consist of seven members elected according to the Education Law of the State of New York. Their terms of office shall be three years.

A person is legally qualified to become a member of the Board of Education if he/she is: a citizen of the United States, at least eighteen years of age, able to read and write and has resided in the school district for at least one year immediately proceeding the election. Not more than one member of a family shall be a member of the Board of Education at the same time. Employees of the school district are precluded from serving on the Board, except the school physician. The Town Supervisor of the Town of Tuxedo shall not serve simultaneously as a board member.
