Board of Education Election – Qualification of Voters

A person shall be entitled to vote at any school district meeting (election and/or vote who is:

- a. a citizen of the United States;
- b. at least 18 years of age or older;
- c. a resident (domiciliary) within the District for a period of at least 30 days immediately preceding the election/vote;
- d. registered to vote on the school district or county rolls.

Any person who would not be qualified to vote under the provisions of Section 5-106 of the Election Law (e.g. convicted felon, adjudged mentally incompetent) may not vote in a school election or vote.
