## Powers and Responsibilities of Board of Education Members

## **New Board Member Orientation**

The magnitude of School Board membership requires knowledge of and orientation to many areas of information and understanding. To assist new Board members, the following methods will be utilized:

- 1. The new member will be given material concerning the role of a Boar member and meet with members of the current Board and Administration to discuss the operation and procedures of the Board.
- 2. Provide the opportunity to attend the New York State School Boards Association and Workshop for New School Board Members.
- 3. Be supplied with a copy of the Board's policies and other pertinent publications and materials.
- 4. Be invited to attend the participate, without vote, all meetings of the Board held between the date of his/her election and the date at which time he/she assumes the duties of Board member. Board members-elect shall not be permitted to attend executive sessions until they have taken the oath of office.
- 5. The Board President or designee shall explain to each Board member-elect the need to ensure the confidentiality of all discussions and/or actions which occur in executive session;
