Middle School – Mrs. Lamb reported that the Middle School has 156 students. The Middle School open house had 92% of families participate. Mrs. Lamb recognized the custodians and other staff for their work at the school.

Elementary Principal - Mr. Veleba reported the elementary has 213 students (including a large group of fourth graders). The elementary had 90% of families attended open house. Summer school was well attended with an average daily attendance of 45.
