

BOARD OF EDUCATION – MEETINGS

Special Meetings

Special meetings of the Board shall be held whenever called by the Board President or by the Clerk of the Board of Education upon the request of any member of the Board, or by the Superintendent of Schools. Notice of such special meetings shall be given to the Board of Education, media and public in accordance with the Open Meetings Law. Such special meetings shall be public meetings.

Except as otherwise provided by law, any action taken at a duly called Special Meeting shall be as valid and effective as if taken at the regular meeting.
