BOARD OF EDUCATION – MEETINGS

Meetings Open to the Public

All meetings of the Board shall be open to the public, except as permitted by law. Executive sessions of the Board, which are not open to the public, may be called and held for proposed, pending, or current litigation; collective negotiations; review of an employee's medical, financial, credit or employment history or matters leading to the appointment, employment, promotion, demotion, discipline, suspension, or removal of a particular individual; the proposed acquisition, sale, or lease of real property; the sale of securities, such as bonds; the preparation, grading, or administration of exams; and mattes that may imperil public safety. No formal action may be taken in executive session except as permitted by law.
