Teachers are encouraged to use citizen volunteers in the instructional program directly affecting the students. Demonstrations, lectures, exhibits, and other presentations by persons possessing unique skills, interests, or experience can significantly enrich the learning environment.

Volunteers as instructional assistants are also encouraged. This indirect contribution to the instructional program should be designed to free the professional teacher from routine, clerical duties.
