VIDEO/DIGITAL CAMERAS ON SCHOOL BUSES

The board authorizes the use of video/digital cameras on district operated school buses for the purpose of reducing discipline problems, thus providing a safer environment for the transportation of students. The reason for recording the transportation environment is to provide school officials, drivers and parents/guardians/custodians with documentation when dealing with inappropriate student behavior. Disciplinary action will be in accordance with policies and procedures on Student Responsibilities and Rights.

The superintendent shall prepare procedures for use of the video/digital equipment on buses, the authorized review process for video images and the proper disposal of said images.
