In 1994, The Old Fort Banking Company established its scholarship program. We are pleased to offer scholarships to Heidelberg University (HU), Tiffin University (TU) and the University of Findlay (UF).

Scholarship Guidelines & Priorities:

- One \$1,000.00 Scholarship will be awarded to HU, TU and UF.
- High School seniors attending Arcadia, Arlington, Calvert, Clyde, Columbian, Cory Rawson, Findlay, Fostoria, Fremont Ross, Hopewell-Loudon, Lakota, Liberty-Benton, McComb, Mohawk, New Riegel, Old Fort, Seneca East, Fremont St. Joseph, Van Buren and Vanlue High School, are eligible to receive the scholarships.
- Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 with intended enrollment in Heidelberg University, Tiffin University, University of Findlay.
- Scholarship funds will be paid prior to the first semester of the student's first year. The funds will be made payable to the student AND the university, to be presented to the university for credit towards tuition for the student's first semester.
- Applicants must have the endorsement of their Guidance Counselor on the application attesting they are qualified for this scholarship program.
- Applications must be received no later than **March 31, 2020**. Late applications will not be accepted.
- Old Fort Banking Company associates and board members' children are not eligible to receive these scholarships.

- Mail one copy of a completed typed application package which includes application, signed Guidance Counselor Statement of Support and School transcript, to the address provided.
