2019-2020 World's Best Workforce Goals

- All children are ready for school.
- All third-graders can read at grade level.
- All racial and economic achievement gaps between students are closed.
- All students are ready for career and college.
- All students graduate from high school.

SMART GOALS

All children are ready for school:

Using census data, 100% of children between their third birthday and the beginning of their kindergarten school year will be screened for school readiness by September 30, 2020.

All 3rd graders can read at grade level:

Using MCA data from the MN report card 65% of 3rd graders in ISD 690 will meet or exceed standards on the 2020 MCA-III Reading Exam. This will be an increase of 2% from 2019.

All racial and economic achievement gaps between students are closed:

High School:

Using MCA data from the MN report card 30% of Asian and 28% American Indian/Alaskan Native high school students in ISD 690 will meet or exceed standards on the 2020 MCA-III Math Assessment. This will be an increase of 5% from each subgroup in 2019.

Using MCA data from the MN report card 55% of Asian and 50% of American Indian/Alaskan Native high school students in ISD 690 will meet or exceed standards on the 2019 MCA-III Reading Assessment. This will be an increase of 5% from 2019.

Elementary:

Using MCA data from the MN report card 47% of Asian and 32% of American Indian/Alaskan Native elementary students in ISD 690 will meet or exceed standards on the 2020 MCA-III Math Assessment. This will be an increase of 4% in each subgroup from 2019.

Using MCA data from the MN report card 65% of Asian and 56% American Indian/Alaskan elementary students in ISD 690 will meet or exceed standards on the 2020 MCA-III Reading Assessment. This will be an increase of 4% from 2019.

All students are ready for career and college:

100% of grade 7-12 students will participate in the RAMP-UP college and career readiness program. All juniors will have taken either the ASVAB or ACT Plus Writing exam during the 2019-2020 school year

All students graduate from high school:

95% of high school students will graduate in 2020. This will be an increase of 2.7% from 2019.
