# Chromebook Care Contract

***This contract is to help students understand the responsibilities they have to care for their chromebook that is being issued during the school year.***

- During the school day, students must have their chromebooks with them or locked in their school lockers. Chromebooks must never be left unattended. Faculty will pick up and give unattended chromebooks to the office.
- Students will pay a per incident fee for repairs made to their assigned chromebooks due to negligence or intent to harm following the guidelines listed below:
  - Level One Repair = \$30.00 Examples include, but not limited to: keyboards, missing keys; lost or damaged chargers.
  - Level Two Repair = \$100.00 Examples include, but not limited to: cracked screens
  - Level Three Repair = up to \$350 for replacement cost of the chromebook designated as unrepairable.. Students will not be allowed to take the chromebook home until payments are made in full.
- If a chromebook is stolen or lost, the student will be expected to pay for the replacement of the missing computer. Stolen chromebooks should be reported immediately to the local police through the High School office.
- Chromebooks may be equipped with a protective case. At no time, should this case be removed. The chromebooks should not be kept in bags where damage may occur.
- Coaches/Sponsors for individual activities may limit whether or not chromebooks are allowed on buses or to particular events.
- It is recommended that chromebooks go home with students each evening for recharging unless other arrangements have been made by the school administration.
- Students are not to deface their chromebook or carrying case in any way, examples include writing names, stickers or painting pictures. If there are any questions, check with the administrator.
- Students are not to remove, deface or alter the USD #393 identifying stickers, labels or barcodes in any way, shape or form.
- The laptop computers should not be left for extended time in places where it will be subject to extreme temperatures or humidity (i.e.: cars or outside on cold or hot days or a steamy locker room).

Students will return their school issued chromebook when they checkout at the end of the school year or when they transfer to another school.
