Earn your babysitting certification from the American Red Cross. Whether you're just starting out or you've cared for your siblings for years and now want to start earning money or even build a business, this program can help. By allowing you to demonstrate your skills to the families seeking your help, a Red Cross Babysitting Certification shows parents that you take your job seriously. This course will provide information on basic care to infants and children, what to do during an emergency, how to choose age-appropriate activities, and recognizing and handling specific behaviors; this class can help you gain the skills and confidence needed for babysitting.

During each class, students will watch a portion of the online Red Cross training which will be followed by an in class discussion about the material viewed. This will allow students to ask questions, answer questions, and role play what they have learned. The online course includes a final exam. Upon successful completion students will each receive a printable certificate.
