Nokomis Junior and Senior High School will hold registration on Monday, August 5th & Tuesday, August 6th.

The schedule will be as follows:

Monday, August 5th 2:00 - 4:00 p.m. & 5:00 - 7:00 p.m.

Tuesday, August 6th 9:00 a.m. - 11:00 a.m.

New students to the district in grades 6-12 can register Wednesday, August 7th from 9:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m. in the appropriate office. New students to the district are required to have a copy of their birth certificate, a student transfer form filled out from their previous Illinois school when they enroll and verification of residency will also be required.

*The parking fee must be paid at registration which will reserve your parking pass. A registration form must be completed and returned to the office **before the first day of school.**

Athletic Participation Fees for Junior High Students - \$35.00 per sport capped at \$60.00 per student per year

Athletic Participation Fees for High School Students - \$40.00 per sport per student capped at \$100.00 per student per year

All non-sport organizational fees are \$20 per club / participation. Please note, no sport or organizational fees may be accepted until all registration / book fees have been paid / processed.

Driver Ed fees (\$50) will be payable after class has started.

All Freshmen **MUST** have a physical and a dental exam and Seniors **MUST** have a 2nd dose of Meningococcal Conjugate Vaccine. The sports physical **does not** meet the requirements for Illinois State School Law for 9th graders. Please use the appropriate form which is available in the high school office.

All 6th grade students **MUST** have a current physical with proof of a TDaP and a dental form completed.
