The Board approved Lunch checks totaling \$18,306.03, Escrow checks totaling \$3,106.00, Student Fee checks totaling 545.95, Cooperative checks totaling 3,662.86 and Activity checks totaling \$22,344.05.

The Elementary Principal reported that the Students will be downtown singing and visiting the Nursing Home, Assisted Living, Mainview Apts, and North Star Services on December 20th. The Elementary program was well attended. The Book Fair went over well. The pajama drive that was sponsored by the elementary school was well received with 110 pairs of pajamas that will be donated to Goldenrod Hills in Creighton to be distributed. School will be dismissed on Thursday and Friday at 2:35 p.m. Christmas break will December 21 – January 5th. Students will return to school on the 6th of January. There will be Preschool on January 16th at 7:00 p.m.

The Superintendent mentioned that he has been in contact with Prochaska & Assoc. regarding our next phase of remodeling. The negotiations committee is very close to settling with the BEA. Final exams will be held on the 19th and 20th of Dec. School will be dismissed at 2:45 p.m. both days. The January BOE meeting will include a reorganizational meeting followed by the regular meeting. This will be held on January 20th at 6:30 p.m.

Committee reports included: American/Civics, Administration Review, Board Policy & Procedures, Negotiations/Staff Relations, Building & Grounds, Transportation, and Budget.

President Hefner reviewed Mr. Alexander's annual administration review. They would like to put a survey on the computer for teachers to also aide in the review of the Superintendent. There were questions from the BOE members if we could start by remodeling the current locker rooms and the north windows of that area. The Board was in agreement that if the next phase could be done in sections that would be less of a burden on tax payers. Mr. Alexander and the negotiations committee are finishing up on the 2020-2021 Master Agreement.

Motion by Eisenhower, seconded by Mackeprang, to table the Master Agreement until the January meeting so they may finalize the 2020-2021 Master Negotiated Agreement.
