SED Leadership Changes

As you've probably seen, the last few months have been even more tumultuous at SED than usual. Since MaryEllen Elia left as Commissioner at the end of August, Executive Deputy Commissioner Beth Berlin has served as Interim Commissioner. But a few weeks ago, she very abruptly and unexpectedly announced that she is leaving SED, effective November 15. With only one Deputy Commissioner left (out of 4 who are usually in place) and with that Deputy Commissioner (Kim Wilkins) only 5 months into her time at SED, the Board of Regents wasn't left with many good options in the short term while they do a search for the next permanent Commissioner. At the November Board of Regents Meeting, they named Shannon Tahoe as "Acting Commissioner," while they search for an "Interim Commissioner" who will then serve until they find a permanent Commissioner.

To fill the Senior Deputy role in the interim, the Board of Regents called John D'Agati out of retirement temporarily. He retired two months ago as the Deputy Commissioner for Higher Education.

They are actively searching for several Assistant and Associate Commissioners, and District Superintendents are being asked to serve on each of those search committees. On November 21, I will be on the search committee at SED interviewing candidates for the position of Assistant Commissioner for Curriculum and Instruction.

Assistant Superintendent LaRose provided the Board with the opening of school reports, information on the National Distance Learning Week 11/4-8/19, Workforce Connections and a Practical Nursing Program Update.

Assistant Superintendent Traynor provided the Board with draft budgets and information highlighting 2020-21 Administrative, Capital, Operations & Maintenance and 600 level Administrative CoSers. Ms. Traynor responded to questions from the Board.
