Eligibility Every Wednesday at 10AM



Eligibility will be checked every Wednesday at 10:00 a.m. Any student who has an F for two consecutive weeks will not be allowed to participate in any school sponsored activity from Thursday morning to the next grade check. A student who is ineligible can practice, but cannot compete or travel to any game/competition.

- Study hall will be from 3:30-4:00 Monday-Thursday beginning the third week of school
- First bell rings at 7:55, class starts at 8AM
- Any student arriving at school more than 15 minutes late (8:15 a.m.) will be considered absent and will be ineligible that day without a professional note.
- Lunch is served from 11:35-12:00
- Conduct cards will be used for behavior


In order to attend EPIC, students must meet the following criteria: "4 or fewer marks on conduct card "90% attendance "all grades 65% or higher
