	Any investigations of violations or possible violations of the law
	Any pending or anticipated litigation or contract negotiation in which the public body is or may become a party. Any matters falling within the attorney-client privilege, to the extent that confidentiality is required in order for the attorney to exercise his ethical duties as a lawyer
Х	Any matter involving the employment, appointment, termination of employment, terms and conditions of employment, evaluation of the
