

'Tis the Season

Flu and cold season is here. Several kids are getting sick and we do have a case of the flu. Just a reminder to talk to your child about preventative measures to avoid sickness. Some measures to take is to wash hands well and often (with soap), keep hands to self, sneeze or cough into inner-elbow or elbow pit, don't pick nose, and avoid rubbing eyes. The County Office of Education may be publishing a cautionary memo regarding the outbreak of the flu. Influenza can incubate for 5 days. Please look for these symptoms to screen your child 101+/- temperature and severe body aches. A cough doesn't need to be present. The flu can last 5-8 days.

If your child has a fever, please do not send him/her to school!!




Yearbook Photos Needed

Box Tops

The way we collect Box Tops is changing! Historically, we have clipped Box Tops from boxes of crackers, cereals, soup can and even parchment paper. The money we earn from all our clippings (10 cents per Box Top) goes straight to our school and is used for classroom supplies and other needs.

How- 1. Download the Box Tops for Education app; 2. Scan your receipt; 3. Earn Money

The best news is that during this transition, our school can get twice the amount of earnings for each Box Top-10 cents for eligible items on scanned receipts and 10 cents for the clipped Box Top. Earn money for Butteville via Box Tops via the Box Tops for Education app, but also keep clipping Box Tops until it phases out completely. Turn clipped Box Tops either to your teachers or the front office!
