

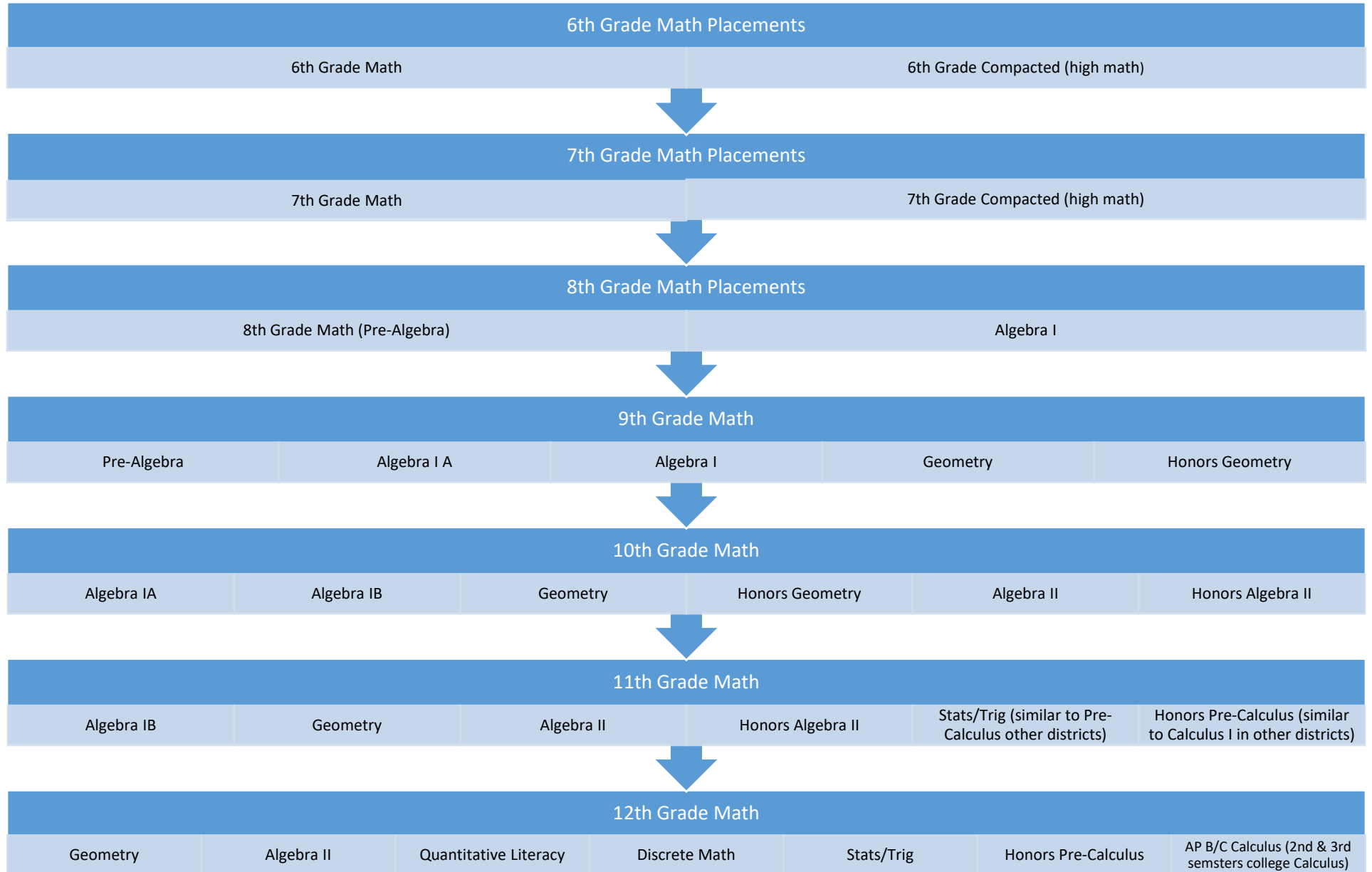

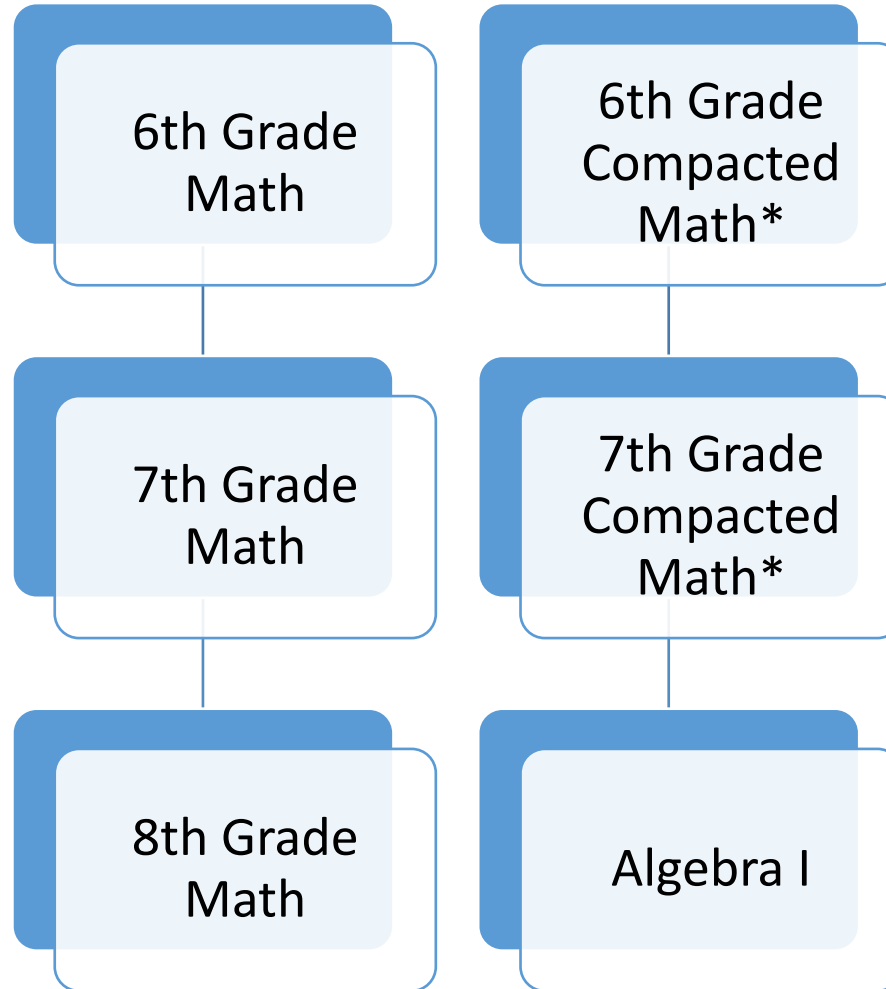

Sequence of Course Placements

The chart below outlines the various course placements offered to students in grades 6-12. Testing and/or acceleration is not needed for any of these placements. Should you want your child to take a course that is listed at a grade level above his/her placement, a request for acceleration is needed. Acceleration does not guarantee placement in Honors or AP classes. Acceleration simply grants access to courses above the students current grade placement. 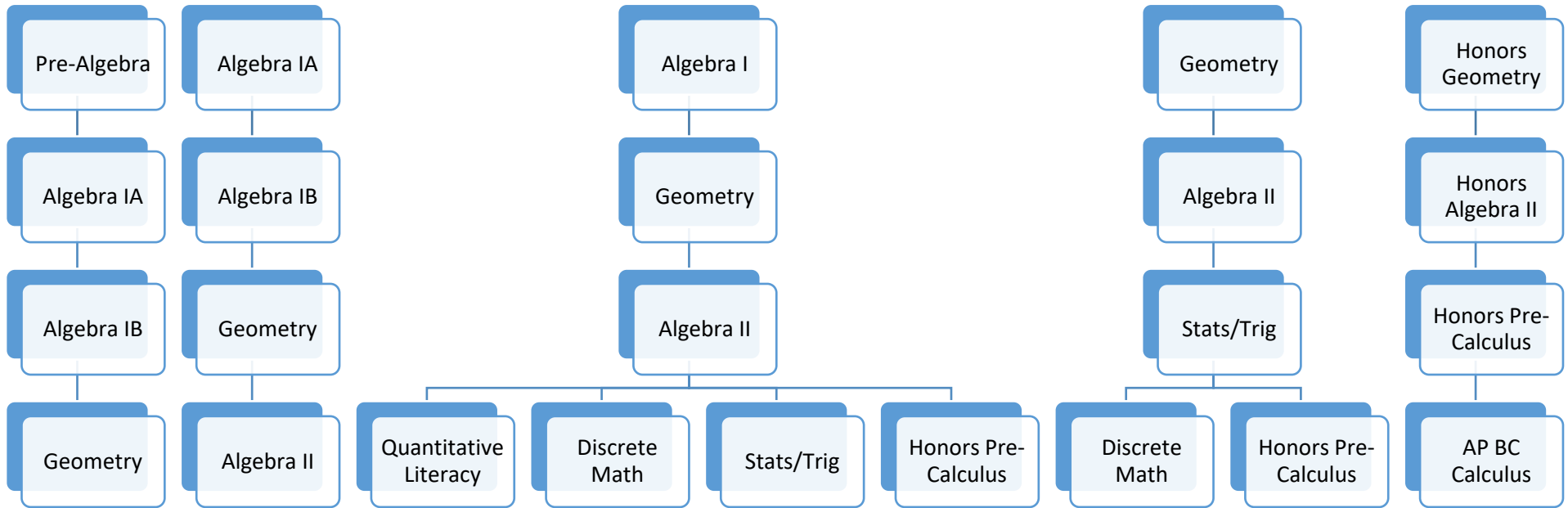


Junior High Math Sequences



*The compacted math sequence uses two years of instruction to cover three years of math content. The sixth grade year is spent covering sixth grade and $\frac{1}{2}$ of seventh grade math. The seventh grade year is spent covering the remaining seventh grade math and all of eighth grade math.
