

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How will my child be evaluated for acceptance into the Scholars Academy?

The completed application with writing assignment and work samples are entered into a rubric. This information along with grades, teacher recommendations, and standardized test scores all add into the final rubric score.

What is the minimum cut score for acceptance into the Scholars Academy?

The scores change every year based on the applicant pool.

When and how will I be notified of an acceptance decision?

Decisions will be mailed the week of March 30, 2020. The Welcome to Scholars Academy night will be Monday, April 13, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. Please keep in mind, this meeting is for students whose complete applications were submitted by March 13, 2020.

What does a schedule at the Scholars Academy look like?

MPMS, THS, and SA follow a block schedule that consists of 90 minute classes. These classes meet every other day with the exception of C Day. Students see all of their teachers on C day.

Will my 6th grader have to take a foreign language?

We expose all sixth graders to foreign language. They will not begin earning the foreign language credit until 7th or 8th grade.
