1. <u>Consideration of the Approval of the Watertown Annual Healthy Food Certification Statement</u> under Section 10-215F of the CT General Statutes (C.G.S)

The Watertown Public Schools District and pursuant to section 10-215f of the Connecticut General Statutes, hereby certifies that all food items offered for sale to students in the school(s) under our jurisdiction, and not exempted from the Connecticut Nutrition Standards published by the Connecticut State Department of Education will meet said standards during the period of **July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017**. These healthy food items include food offered for sale to students at all times in all schools and from all sources including, but not limited to, school stores, vending machines, school cafeteria and any fundraising activities on school premises.

Pursuant to section 10-215F of the Connecticut General Statutes, I hereby acknowledge that the Watertown Board of Education will exclude from certification food items that do not meet the Connecticut Nutrition Standards, provided that such food is sold in connection with an event occurring after the end of the regular school day or on the weekend, such sale is at the location of the event, and such food is not sold from a vending machine or school store.
