Players must play in the age appropriate divisions. Any request to "play up" must be submitted in writing to SYBSA board. Child will be signed up in whichever age group their birthday falls on day of sign-ups. After sign up completion a special meeting will be held to evaluate all requests and move children up on an "as needed" basis only. This is for safety and to abide by Tri-county rules as closely as possible. No child will be turned away for inability to pay.

Zero Tolerance Policy: Any person who behaves in an inappropriate or unsportsmanlike manor during games or practices, may be denied admission to league events for up to one year. Examples: injuring, threatening, harassment, intimidation, using vulgar or obscene language/profanities, being under the influence of alcohol or any other substance, possessing a weapon, failing to obey umpire direction, illegal or disruptive behavior. Any incident considered a violation of the Zero Tolerance Policy will be submitted and reviewed by the SYBSA board of directors.
