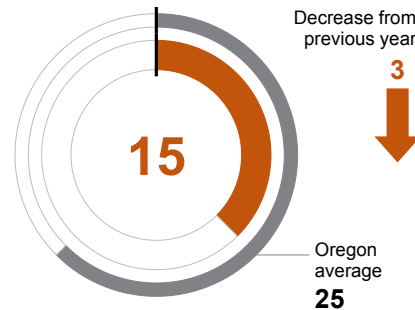

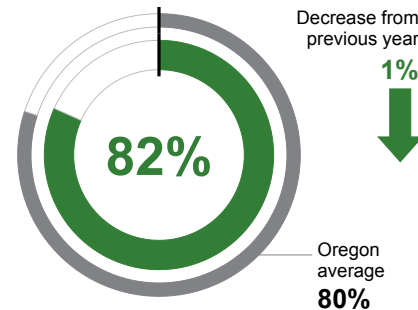
CLASS SIZE

REGULAR ATTENDERS

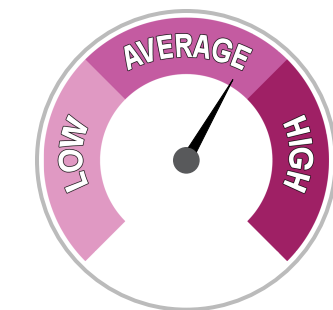
Students who attended more than 90% of their enrolled school days.

INDIVIDUAL STUDENT PROGRESS

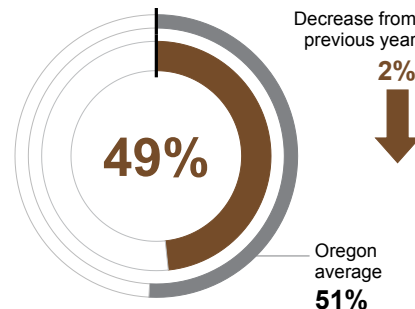
Year-to-year progress in English language arts and mathematics.

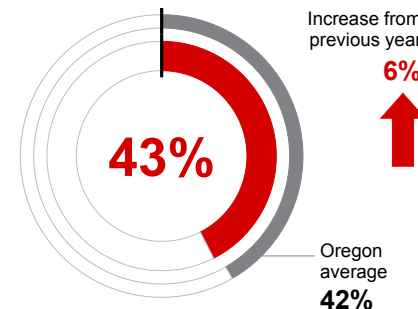
ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS

School Goals

Our emphasis for this next school year is to continue to improve our school organizations, academic focus, and instructional practices. To help with this goal, Applegate staff will routinely meet as an academic data team and use the districts assessment system (easyCBM) to frequently monitor students' progress towards the Common Core State Standards. This formative assessment approach allows the team to review each student's academic progress and can give support when needed.

State Goals

The Oregon Department of Education is partnering with school districts and local communities to ensure a 90% on-time, four year graduation rate by 2025. To progress toward this goal, the state will prioritize efforts to improve attendance, provide a well-rounded education, invest in implementing culturally responsive practices, and promote continuous improvement to close opportunity and achievement gaps for historically and currently underserved students.

Applegate is proud of the comprehensive educational program it offers. It is designed to meet the specific educational needs of each child. Our experienced faculty and staff work closely with parents and students to build a safe educational environment that facilitates the continuing academic success story we have all come to know and expect. About Our School

BULLYING, HARASSMENT, AND SAFETY POLICIES

All staff focus on positive behavior with the goal of creating a positive school climate where students learn, grow and feel safe. School climate has bearing on attendance rates, academic achievement, and graduation rates. A positive school climate helps students develop the social and emotional skills they will need to become productive members of society. With this school wide emphasis, our discipline and bullying issues are minimal. Students who feel they need guidance or emotional support have access to a school counselor.

EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

All our students participate in "Team Time" at the beginning of the day and we provide full Music and Physical Education programs. Students in grades five and six can participate in Band and Choir. Our library has a very extensive collection of books and all classes have a weekly scheduled time for book check out. Applegate invites many guest speakers to our school. Some past examples would be: Sluggo, Bring Recycling, Smokey the Bear, and Fire Safety. Along with this we do participate in field trips to local educational attractions. We also offer these additional activities: Bible Club, after school art program, sports for 5th and 6th grade students, Oregon Battle of the Books, and the Territorial Sports Program for K-6 grade students.

PARENT ENGAGEMENT

Studies have shown that children do better in school when their parents take an active and ongoing interest in their child's education, classroom, activities, and school. We encourage parents to work closely with faculty and administration in order to maintain the close communication that is so vital for the success of our educational program.
