2020 SENIOR MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP GENERAL RULES AND GUIDELINES

Scholarship Available: Up to two \$500.00 scholarships per year.

Eligibility Requirements:

Students pursuing a post-secondary degree in a music-related field may be given preference for the scholarships. Sex, race or religion is not conditions for eligibility for the scholarships. The student must be enrolled as a senior in the Northeastern Local School District. The student must be enrolled in the instrumental and/or vocal music program until time of graduation.

The student must graduate from Tinora High School.

Application Procedure:

1. All applications for the scholarships must be on the official Tinora Music Booster application form found on the following website: <https://www.tinora.org/o/northeastern-local-schools/page/music-department--13>. All information must be typed, except the student signature. If needed, additional sheets may accompany the application form and must be typed. Incomplete applications or late submissions will not be considered.
2. Completed forms must be submitted, in a sealed envelope, to the Tinora Music Boosters mailbox in the high school office to the attention of Michele Diehl.
3. Completed forms must be submitted no later than February 21, 2020.
