

Dear Parent/Guardian:

Many states, including Illinois, in the past several years have passed laws with the intent of increasing the awareness of child sexual abuse. You may have heard of this legislation under its more common name, Erin's Law, in honor of Erin Merryn, a brave young woman who has crossed the country advocating for laws that will increase awareness of this crime against children. One of the requirements of this law is that schools provide an age appropriate curriculum to all students relating to sexual abuse prevention, which may include a variety of discussions, activities, videos and role play scenarios. The purpose of the lessons is to provide students with tools needed for personal safety and to provide a nurturing and caring environment open for disclosure of any incidents.

During the 2019-2020 school year, Growing Strong Sexual Assault Center (non-profit local organization) will be presenting a lesson to your student's class to meet the requirements of Erin's Law. The following concepts will be discussed:

- Ways to be safe, such as but not limited to, wearing a bike helmet, asking before petting a dog crossing the road, and safe and unsafe touches
- Ask First Rule, for example, asking before going to a friend's house
- How to say "no" and tell a trusted adult

February 3rd and February 4, 2020, Sullivan High School will be hosting the Growing Strong Sexual Assault Center to present Erin's Law information to our students. Through the program aimed at educating and empowering students, we want to provide your student with the knowledge and skills to use if ever affected by sexual violence and empower them to be safe.
