REQUIRED DOJO INFORMATION INCLUDED WITHIN YOUR MESSAGE

Parents will be required to use dojo, write a parent note, or come in person for all dismissal changes while your children are at school. ALL MESSAGES ARE TO BE COMPLETED BEFORE 3:00 p.m. Messages sent after 3:00 will not be confirmed or granted. Requirements are as follows:

- Office Pick-up must state who is picking up your child in the office/ <u>Drivers License</u> will be required for Identification purposes.
- Bus Change must include the <u>bus #</u>, complete <u>address</u>, <u>person</u> at that location to get them. Please never say "ride the bus home!" We have found that they are not really going to their actual home address. It may be grandparent, aunt, uncle, sitter, etc. This is extremely confusing. Please <u>provide all information!</u>.
- Car Tag must include the <u>car tag number</u>.

VISITOR & CHAPERONE REQUIREMENTS

- Visitors coming into the building must have a valid government issued ID.
- To go beyond the front entrance during the school day, you must have a
 <u>valid background check on file</u>. Students are learning, and teachers are teaching.
 If you have items for your child, please drop them off at the front office. Our front office staff members are more than happy to make the delivery during the teacher's allotted prep time.
