# Week of January 21st 2020

### Reading

We are continuing City of Ember. Students will learn more about mood, author's purpose, setting, and theme this week.

## Writing

We are writing historical information books about the Revolutionary War. Writers who are writing a story about a time in history think about the three most important elements in any story: Character, setting and conflict. When writers are writing essays about historical topics, they think about all they know about essay writing: the structure, the thesis, and the supports. They also need to do research to find facts to develop and support their idea. They will selfreflect and use an information writing checklist. Finally, they will tackle the new piece of information writing by coming up with a research plan.

#### Math

We will continue to practice multiplication. Some students will use repeated subtraction and multiples to find quotients, use partial quotients to divide by 1 digit divisors, explore division with regrouping, use place value to help while dividing and learn to check an answer.

### Science

Students will explore how high the hills of a roller coaster can be. In the activity, Bumper Coasters (Part II), students add hills to the Bumper Coaster they built in Mystery 2 and experiment to build a deeper understanding of hills and energy.
