The school board, on behalf of and with extensive participation by the community, should develop a consensus among its members regarding the nature of the enterprise the school board governs, the purposes it serves, the constituencies it should consider, including student representation, and the results it intends to produce.

	Through intentional partnership with parents and the community, the International Falls School District prepares every student to become a contributing citizen by developing their maximum potential within a safe and inclusive climate of mutual respect and trust.
IV.	REVIEW
	The school board will review the school district's mission statement along with the strategic plan on an ongoing basis.
