Just follow these simple guidelines:

Include the following information on a separate piece of paper, taped to the back of the photo(s):

- 1. Student's name, grade, age, signature and full home mailing address.
- 2. Parent or legal guardian's name, signature and contact information (phone and/or e-mail).
- 3. Student's school name and city
- 4. Title and description (100 words or less) explaining why the subject of the photography was selected. Include the name and location of the subject.
- 5. Photos should be 8"x10" and printed on photo paper. Manipulation of photographs is discouraged. Students may submit up to (3) photographs each. Entries must be postmarked by March 30th, 2020
