Face-to-Face Math Course (with Mr. Parker)

For math, Ovid-Elsie High School will be offering face-to-face sessions taught by Ovid-Elsie personnel starting June 13 - June 30 for students that need to make up a math course from this school year. There is no cost for this option. **There is no online format for math classes.**

Online Course for all other subjects through Acellus (with Ms. Hoffman)

June 6 - August, 2022

The cost for the online Accelus course is \$300. The district will pay the cost of the class, however a \$50 deposit will be collected at the time of sign-up. Checks can be made out to Ovid-Elsie High School. The deposit will be returned to the parent upon the successful completion and passing of the class. Should your child not pass the class, the money will go towards the cost of reimbursing the school for the cost of the failed coursework.

School internet can be accessed through in the school parking lots. Students will not be supervised by Ovid-Elsie personnel if they choose to utilize the parking lots for internet service.

Acellus students have until August 3, 2022 to complete a minimum of 85% of the course requirements with 60% accuracy to earn credit. Credit recovery administrator or teacher will communicate with the student whether they will or will not receive credit.
