	Classroom teachers are providing differentiated instruction to
	meet students' needs, but the range of learning needs requires
	more support for strategic interventions within the regular
	classroom.

	growth; 2) Implement differentiated instructional practices to

	would allow for teachers to have fewer lunch and recess
	duties when more planning time could be allotted and more
	time also would be available for teachers and administrators
	to hold post-conferences following classroom observations -
	- an essential component of the Marshall Teacher Evaluation
	model.

GOALS AND EXPECTED BENEFITS:	<ul> <li>The goals and benefits would include more individualized and small group Tier 1 and Tier 2 classroom RTI support for grades K through 4 that would improve student performance within literacy and mathematics, as well as improve student behavioral expectations as needed through additional classroom support.</li> <li>Additional goals and benefits would include much-needed professional planning time for teachers, as well as time for valuable post-conferences following teacher evaluation observations.</li> </ul>
CONSEQUENCES OF NON-APPROVAL:	<ul> <li>Students who require additional RTI academic and behavioral support will have less access to specialized instruction.</li> <li>Teachers will continue to have less professional planning time than their middle and high school colleagues.</li> </ul>
LOWER COST ALTERNATIVE (IF APPLICABLE):	We do not have a lower cost alternative to propose.  As a school of such a large size, we have struggled with having just two general education Ed Tech III's. They are pulled almost daily to cover classrooms when we do not have enough substitute teachers, as well as to cover classrooms when teachers need to attend IEP meetings. Prior to the FY12 school year, Pond Cove had over 10 regular education Ed Techs, but the positions were eliminated. We are seeking to partially restore this much-needed support.
