It is limited to educational funds only. Payment will be made directly to the college the recipient is planning to attend.

Applicants must:

- A. Return a letter of recommendation from a teacher or a coach.
- B. Submit an essay answering the following 6 questions:
 - 1. How have you served as a leader on your team?
 - 2. How have you impacted your community in a positive manner?
 - 3. What do you feel is your biggest contribution to your team and why?
 - 4. What groups or organizations are you involved in and why?
 - 5. Give an example of an obstacle or challenge you have faced during the sports season and how you overcame it.
 - 6. What importance do you feel athletics have played in your life and how will you use those experiences to help you achieve your goals and impact others?
