| JUSTIFICATION (HOW PROPOSAL SUPPORTS DISTRICT'S 5-YEAR PLAN with SUPPORTING DATA): | Goal \# 1-Ensure opportunities for the success of all students by providing a high-quality and comprehensive instructional program. <br> Teachers will be in a better position to differentiate instruction and meet the individual needs of students. <br> See Enrollment and Staffing tab of budget binder for data. <br> Grade 5 with 119 students and 5 teachers has an average class size of 23.8 students. <br> Historical enrollment data for the past 9 years shows new enrollments in Grade 5 ranging from 3 in 20102011 to 11 students in 2015-2016. |
| GOALS AND EXPECTED BENEFITS: | This will allow for class sizes across grades 5-8 that are in line with K-12 classrooms and with the School Board Class Size Policy guidelines. |
| CONSEQUENCES OF NON-APPROVAL: | The addition of two students enrolling to the Grade 5 cohort for 2017-2018 will exceed an average class size of 24 students. <br> The class sizes for the Grade 5 cohort would be an anomaly within the middle school, and average class sizes at PC and HS are not anticipated to exceed 19 students. <br> Class sizes that exceed the guidelines pose challenges for teachers to meet the individual needs of students. |
