

Hello all,

I wanted to write a letter to say hello to our 2023 football family. Our coaches are Ty Nordby, Josh Epperle, and Lucas Greff. We are extremely excited to have our coaches back!

All students are required to supply their own mouth guards, water bottles, practice jerseys and shoes. Practice jerseys are REQUIRED to practice as it becomes a safety issue. Students are NOT allowed to practice in their uniforms as we do not want them ruined. Please let the coaches or Sara know if you need assistance getting a practice jersey. They can be found at Dunhams in Dickinson if you are looking. Nut cups/groin guard (for lack of a better terms) are not required, though know that there are situations where your child may be hit and it could hurt. It is strongly recommended, but not required.

There is a fee as well as a deposit check due to the cost of running the program. We are required to pay for our coaches, refs, etc. and need to be able to cover the operating costs. As a way to help, I am requiring all families to help with the concession stands as well. I will have a sign-up sheet for families and will keep track of those helping. If you do not complete your allotted quarter in the concessions, I will be keeping the deposit check.

Uniforms will be handed out prior to the jamboree and then collected the day of the last game. If you have completed your time and returned all of the equipment, I will return your deposit check that day as well.
