CALL REGULAR BOARD MEETING TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

President Chad Ruppert called the Public Hearing on FY20 Budget Proposal to order and roll call was taken with seven board members present. Board members present were Janssen, Ruppert, Eisenbarth, Bauman, Fesser, Tarter, and Gasparich. Also present were Superintendent Doerr, Principal McDowell, and Principal Reedy.

Dr. Doerr gave an overview of the FY 20 budget. The budget is balanced across all funds. Although fairly conservative in my numbers as I always am, the budget remains in the black. This budget also include the District acting as the fiscal agent for ChrisMont, all the new special education expenditures, and sales tax money (which some will be transferred to pay bonds as promised). Again, the only part of the budget that is still fluid is the Transportation budget as the reimbursement dollars have not been calculated by ISBE or released at this time.
