## **TECHNOLOGY INTEGRATION SPECIALIST**

The Technology Integration Specialist, under the direction of the Technology Director, shall provide professional development and assist teachers designing lessons that integrate technology. The specific responsibilities shall be:

- 1. Provide professional development for teachers on general technology skills, software programs, hardware tools, and technology teaching methods.
- 2. Assist teachers in designing lessons that integrate technology into their curriculum areas and model good teaching-with-technology skills for teachers and students.
- 3. Act as a resource person who can acquaint teachers, administrators, and other staff members with Web sites, content-specific software, and general software that will be best for a chosen project.
- 4. Serve as an advocate and support person for teachers who are working to integrate technology into their lessons. Help publicize good practices that work with other teachers so the ideas may be shared.
- 5. Promote the benefits of technology integration to teachers, school board members, administrators, parents, and the community.
- 6. Maintain understanding of the curriculum and the academic goals of the district.
- 7. Maintain knowledge of emerging but practical educational technology trends as they relate to classroom instruction.
- 8. Other duties as assigned by Technology Director.
