Network Administrator

The Network Administrator, under the supervision of the Technology Director, is responsible for district computer network planning, administration, and operations activities.

Specific Responsibilities

- 1. Plan, administer, and supervise all computer network functions and hardware.
- 2. Plan and maintain wireless connectivity.
- 3. Deploy and maintain firewalls.
- 4. Supervise the maintenance of all servers.
- 5. Maintain VoIP phone systems.
- 6. Plan and supervise the installation of cabling.
- 7. Work with the Technology Director to plan resources, budget, and personnel needs.
- 8. Maintain comprehensive documentation of network layout.
- 9. Write script/application/web programming as needed.
- 10. Assist in the supervision of other technology staff.
- 11. Perform other duties as assigned by the Technology Director.
