

Vaping Lesson

Goals:

- To have students walk away with increased knowledge about vaping
- Exposure to MN student voices in the two videos
- Increase students' knowledge of resources
- Gain data for our school to use to continue to address the issue of vaping

Resources Needed for this Lesson:

- Students will need access to a phone or chrome book to complete a quiz and a survey
- PowerPoint
 - I will plan to send out to students via email after CORE as well
 - Links to quiz, answers to quiz, videos, survey are in yellow
 - Slide 1: Goals for activity. Let them know this is not a comprehensive vaping unit! :)
 - Slide 2: Kahoot
 - I made the Kahoot public so each advisory should be able to play! The link should lead you to Kahoot. You click the green "PLAY AS GUEST" and then play CLASSIC. You will then see the join code for your advisory. You don't need an account to have students play. In case you need to look for it, the title is "Vaping Nov 2019 CORE."
 - Slide 3: Read through the answers to the Kahoot Quiz.
 - Slide 4: 2 embedded videos. There are a couple of questions to guide them. (about 13 minutes)
 - Slide 5: Videos from school staff about consequences
 - Slide 6: Anonymous Google Survey
 - Slide 7: Opportunities for involvement
 - Slide 8-10: Point out resources--more videos, resources to quit (including text lines and apps)
