Carneal's parents, Octavia Moore (step-father, Wadie Moore) and Neal Jones, along with the Silas Carneal Jones Foundation and Little Rock Parkview High School want his memory to live on by continuing with the "Silas Carneal Jones Memorial Golf Tournament, which is annually held in March

The Foundation has awarded 62 scholarships since 2007, and will add six \$500 scholarships this school year.
