

# **HOPE Scholarship Application**

As a <u>sponsored senior</u> in UA Little Rock Children International (CI), you are eligible to apply for one of our 2020 HOPE Scholarships! The HOPE Scholarship provides additional funding and support through one-on-one meetings during the first year of college/trade school.

Scholars may be awarded up to \$1500 per year — with the possibility of renewal. Scholarship funds are sent directly to your college/technical/trade program of choice and may cover tuition, books, or other fees.

 Be a current sponsored senior enrolled in UA Little Rock CI <u>AND</u> plan on attending a college/technical/trade program in the fall of 2020

--OR---

 Have been a sponsored student with UA Little Rock CI when you graduated from high school <u>AND</u> plan on attending a college/technical/trade program in the fall of 2020

# The following application items are due by Saturday, February 15, 2020

No late applications will be accepted!

1 Complete Application & 1 Complete Essay  (Available here or online at ualr.edu/children/hope-scholarship)
2 Letter of Recommendation from a member of your community or teacher – these people cannot be related to you.
1 Official school transcript. Must show CUMULATIVE GPA
1 Copy of your highest ACT, SAT, or Accuplacer score (This is usually on your transcript)

We highly recommend submitting applications online, but applications can also be submitted through email (hope@ualr.edu) or at the CI office. After the application deadline, the Selection Committee will review all applications and call qualifying applicants to schedule an interview.

Award recipients will be notified during March.
