

## Concurrent Credit

Signing up for early college/concurrent courses at Henderson State involves two primary steps:

1. Apply using the online Google application set up specifically for your high school. The link can be found here:

2. Complete and return the Parental Consent form to the Counselor's Office at BHS. The link can be found at the top of the student application if you do not have a paper copy.

**Important Notes:** To qualify for enrollment, students must have an ACT composite of 19 and a high school GPA of 2.50.

Once all students are admitted as concurrent students, a list of admitted eligible students will be sent to the Concurrent Credit Coordinator at Benton High School. Rosters of students requesting to enroll in concurrent credit will be sent to HSU when school resumes in January. Those students will be charged \$50 per 3-hour course. Invoices will be sent at the beginning of the spring term. Students who qualify for free/reduced lunches may be eligible for a tuition fee waiver. Contact your counselor for more information.

**Complete the online application and submit the Parental Consent form to the Counselor's Office by Friday, November 22 to enroll in concurrent credit for Spring 2020.**  
Your last chance to earn a qualifying score is the December ACT test.
