


The Thurston County Spelling Contest will be hosted by and held at Winnebago Public Schools Wednesday, February 12th at 10:00 am


This week we have been talking about popcorn, pirates, and pigs! Can you guess what letter we are on?




Writing Class







Second Grade Math Vocabulary Terms

- Algebraic Thinking unknown, size, different, expanded form
- Base Ten Operations compare, integer, sequence, pattern, classification, solve, tens, hundreds
- Measurement & Data season, equivalent, degree, currency, tally, outcome, elapsed
- Geometry rotate, perimeter, dimensions, trapezoid, octagon, parallel
- Try to use some of these words in conversation at home. Examples:

-Can you use a pattern when setting the table for dinner? -How fast can you run around the perimeter of the house?
