

BOARD HIGHLIGHTS

Board Highlights provides summary information from the Aromas-San Juan Unified School District board meetings.

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School Safety Plans were approved by the Board. Administration will begin to organize professional development for all employees to support the implementation of the plans.

Information Items:

- The **Board Member Appointment Process for <u>Trustee Area 3</u>** is underway. Applications are available on the district website and must be received at the District Office no later than 4:30 pm on October 24, 2022. On November 2, 2022 a Special Board Meeting will be held in the District Annex to interview and select a new Board Member during its Open Session. The new board member will be seated officially on Dec. 14, 2022.
- Interim Superintendent Dill-Varga will finalize membership lists for four committees (Budget, Facilities, Curriculum and Technology), establish meeting dates, and communicate to all members of upcoming meeting dates and times. The first Budget committee meeting will be November 9, 2022 at 4:30 pm in the District Annex.

Action Items:

- Several presentations occurred related to the future construction and modernization or replacement of facilities.
 - Measure M has about 2.89 M left to spend for designated projects, including air conditioning.
 - A review of two potential plans related to San Juan Elementary School were reviewed as we await news from the State-hopefully by Thanksgiving- on its future: modernization or replacement.
 - Measure O Bonds (30M) are a funding source for the San Juan project. Our Bond consultant presented information about initial issuance of up to 5M to give the district needed cash to begin these projects. The Board voted to begin the process to issue these bonds.
- Interim Superintendent Dill-Varga presented a **new management organizational chart** which the Board approved. This plan begins the rebuilding of the leadership structure necessary to take the district into the future. The Board approved **several new or refreshed job descriptions** which will be posted, seeking quality candidates to support the work for all students. These positions include: Director of Curriculum and Instruction (certificated) and several classified positions to assist cabinet members in HR, Tech, Special Ed, Business, and C/I.
