Jivan's educational vitae is also impressive including a B.A. in Mathematics and History from University of California, Santa Cruz, and Ed credentials from San Francisco State University. She is also a doctoral candidate completing her doctoral degree from the University of California, Berkeley's Graduate School of Education. Her focus is Leadership in Educational Equity Programs. She is well prepared to assist us with assessing our programs through this lens of equity and skilled in MTSS (multi-tiered systems of support).
