Dear Director of Guidance/Counseling:

Baylor University annually awards scholarships through the Carr P. Collins Scholars Program to students who have demonstrated leadership through service. Collins Scholars are awarded a minimum of \$5,350 their first year, renewable for three additional years. For consideration, applicants must:

- have a minimum combined math and evidenced-based reading and writing score of 1310 on the SAT or a minimum of 28 on the ACT
- complete a balanced college preparatory program including history, science, and a foreign language
- rank in the top quarter of their graduating class
- be a bona fide resident of the state of Texas

The enclosed Carr P. Collins Scholars Program brochure contains additional information and application procedures. For the application, please refer students who meet the eligibility criteria stated above to baylor.edu/admissions/CarrPCollins.

Baylor also offers other academic scholarships through our President's Gold, Provost's Gold, Deans' Gold and Founders' Gold Scholarship programs. These scholarships range in value from \$32,000 to \$88,000 divided evenly over four years of undergraduate study. We consider students for these awards by virtue of their application for admission to Baylor. We strongly encourage your students to utilize Baylor's online Scholarship calculator (<https://www.baylor.edu/estimator>) to determine their eligibility for an academic scholarship.

COLLINS SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY

Recipients must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- be admitted to the University
- be in the top quarter of their graduating class
- have a minimum score of 1310 (combined Math and Evidenced-Based Reading and Writing) on the Scholastic Assessment Test (SAT) or a minimum score of 28 on the American College Test (ACT)
- have completed a balanced college preparatory program including history, science and a foreign language
- be a bona fide resident of the state of Texas

To apply for the Carr P. Collins Scholarship students must submit:

1. Completed scholarship application
2. Resume of high school honors, awards, achievements and extracurricular activities
3. Handwritten personal essay of no more than 500 words
4. Nomination from a teacher, counselor or principal
