- Provide proof of college acceptance letter to the targeted school to be attended in the Fall of 2020. If acceptance letter is not received by March 27, 2020 please forward via email then hard copy via mail when received
- Perform Community Service Hours: with minimum of 100 hours
- Obtain 3 letters of recommendation: Can be received from any of the following individuals:
  - o English Language Arts Teacher
  - o Math Teacher
  - o Science Teacher
  - o Social Studies Teacher
  - o Principal/Assistant Principal
  - 1 letter may also be submitted from your Church Pastor, Community Service Director, School Club Director, or any In-School Service Activity that you are involved in

(These recommendations are to attest to the candidate's moral fiber and character. No relatives may submit a letter of recommendation.)

All letters of recommendation must be provided on organization letterhead with title of writer.
