Lunch Program 2023-2024

Students may choose to bring a lunch from home or eat the hot lunch offered at school. Menus will be sent home monthly with the school calendar, and are available on our website www.okawvalley.org

HOT LUNCH INFORMATION

Lunch and snack money must be sent on the first attendance day of each week. Money should be sent in an envelope with an information slip included in the envelope. If you have more than one child, all money can be sent in one envelope as long as the slip is marked appropriately for each child. You must pay for breakfast, lunch, and snacks (kindergartners only) in advance. IOne serving of milk is provided with hot lunch. If you have any questions about your balance you can login to Skyward to see that information OR contact the office at any time.

SACK LUNCH INFORMATION

Please keep in mind that there are only two cafeteria supervisors during each lunch period. **Students should be able to open the packages that they bring from home.** We do help when necessary, however the students must be patient since there are only two adults to help. For instance if your child loves "lunchables", but they can't open them you could take them out of the original packaging and put it in ziplock bags. We encourage all the students to attempt first before they ask for help. We are trying to promote independence.

An afternoon snack of juice or milk is available to Kindergarten students only. <u>The snack drink is</u> **not** included in the **Free/Reduced** lunch program Please send in payment to the office or pay online.
