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Plato/Edmentum: A web-based curriculum used during computer time to strengthen concept knowledge. It features standards based problem-solving and online assessment, interactive simulation, and direct tutorial practice to create a superior learning environment. Founded in innovation more than 50 years ago, Plato/Edmentum is committed to being educators' most trusted partner in creating successful student outcomes everywhere learning occurs. Plato licenses are purchased and used not only at the ACHIEVE Learning Center location in Pontiac, but also in schools across the county who have requested access to it.



Services:

Student Tutoring: The center provides regular tutoring during the school year which is offered after school on Tuesday and Thursdays. Tutoring services help students in the areas of remedial academic needs, homework support, and learning style assessment for underachieving students. Students split each session time between working individually with a teacher on concept knowledge or homework and the other half of the time is spent on the computer utilizing the individualized web-based Plato curriculum.

Credit Recovery: Credit Recovery is a program offered as an opportunity for a student, who has failed a course, to complete the coursework at the ACHIEVE Learning Center or at their home school. The school district issuing the course credit must approve the credit recovery course in order for credit to be granted. The Credit Recovery/Plato program is an internet based instructional program offering state approved curriculum on a self-paced schedule.

Diploma Recovery: Diploma Recovery is a program offered as an opportunity for an adult, who has dropped out of their respective high school, to earn their high school diploma by completing the core courses in order for credit to be applied toward a diploma. The Diploma Recovery/Plato program is an internet based instructional program which offers state approved curriculum on a self-paced schedule. The Diploma Recovery is completed at the ACHIEVE Learning Center.

Pass'em On: The Pass'em On program is for students who need to complete course work in order to be passed on to the next grade level. A home school district will state the amount of time to be completed and the concepts to be learned. This program is utilized in schools who utilize Plato or can be completed at the ACHIEVE Learning Center, especially during the summertime.
