2019-20 Preliminary Budget Synopsis June 17, 2019

Revenues:

Local Sources

- Taxes Increased by 2.5%; 18 mills (previous year had a headlee rollback)
- Pokagon Revenue same as 2018-19

State Sources

- State Aid Per Pupil Increase \$120 most likely (this is not known at this time)
- Students 2,184 Fall 2018-19; Middle Cities Enrollment Projections 2,165 for 2019-20 (Method 2 of the report interesting this year each method is within two students of the other methods used to calculate the number; usually there is a large difference between the three methods)
